Any edition is acceptable, with cadenza of the soloists' choice

Up to three finalists in each category will be selected to compete in the final round on February 28, 2009. Each finalist will receive a cash award, in terraced amounts from first to third place. At the judge's discretion, first place winners will perform in concert with The Flute Symphony of Lexington as the accompanying ensemble. Winning soloists agree to attend a minimum of 2 rehearsals prior to the performance.
